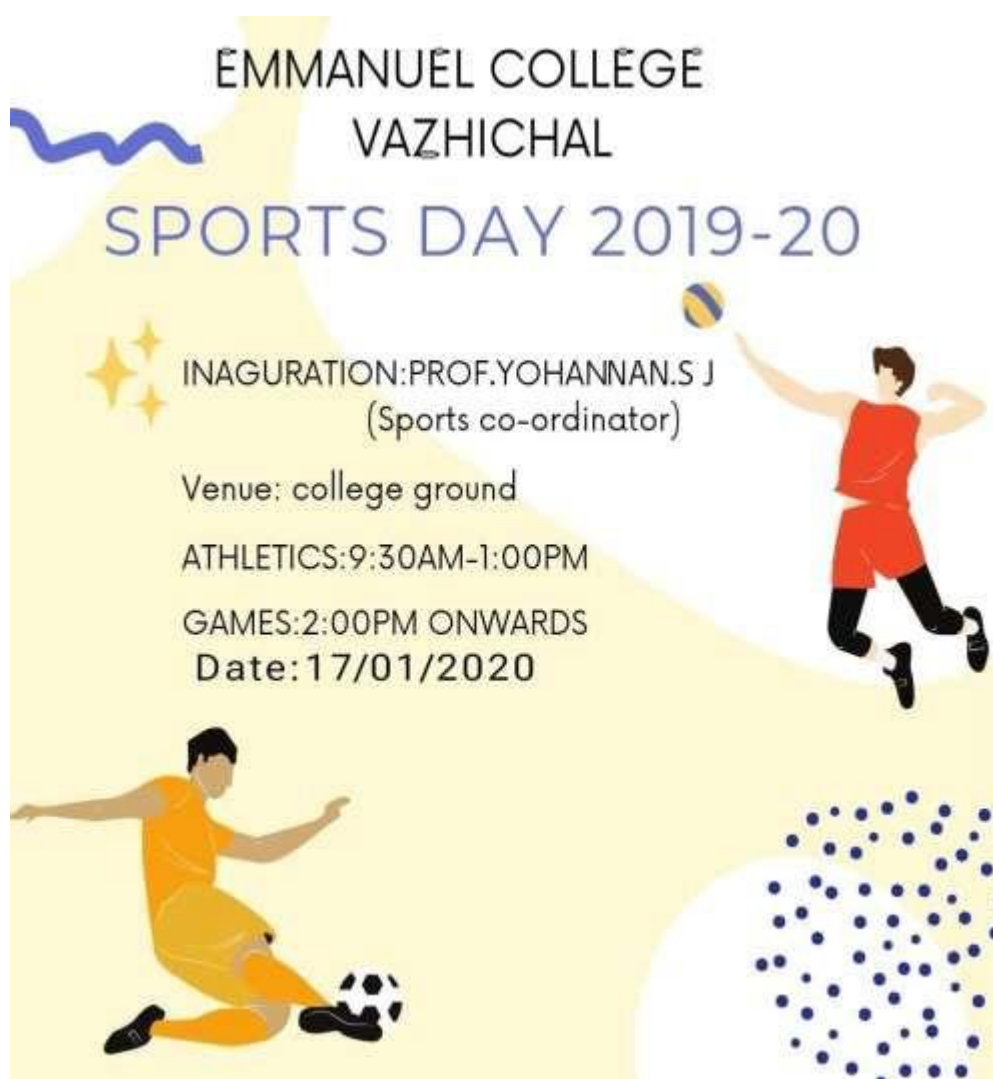
REPORT ON THE ANNUAL SPORTS MEET 2019-2020

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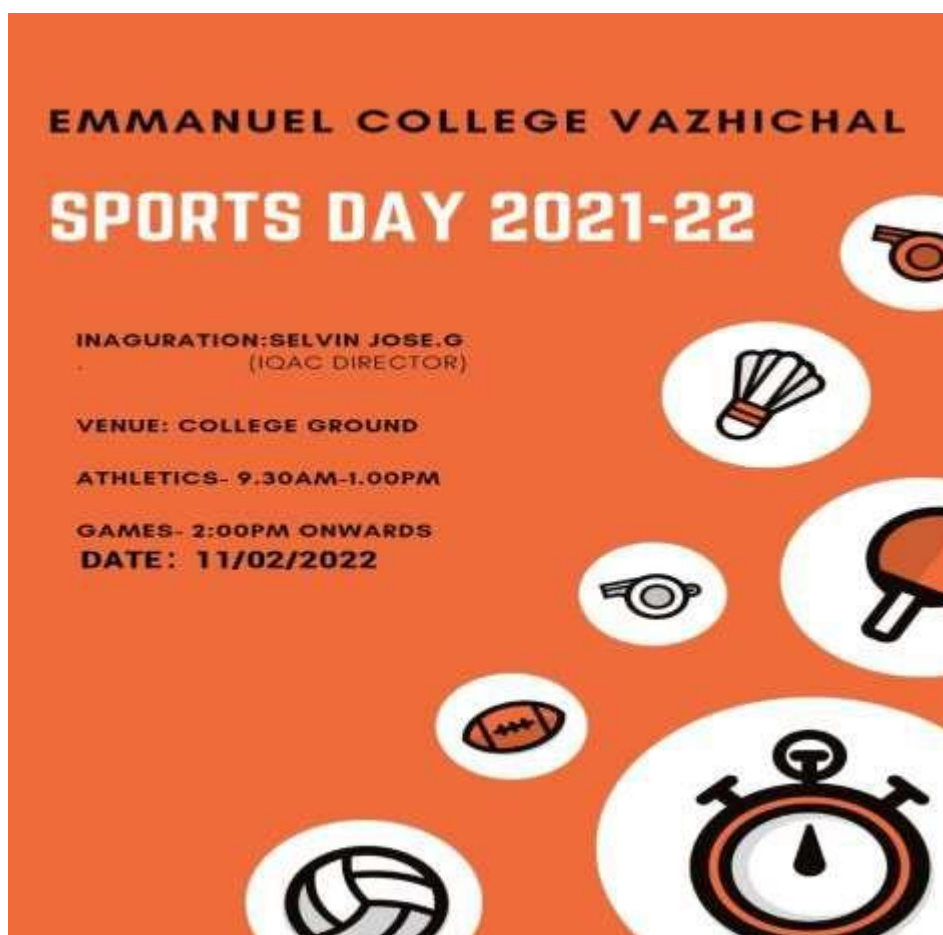
REPORT ON THE ANNUAL SPORTS MEET 2021-22

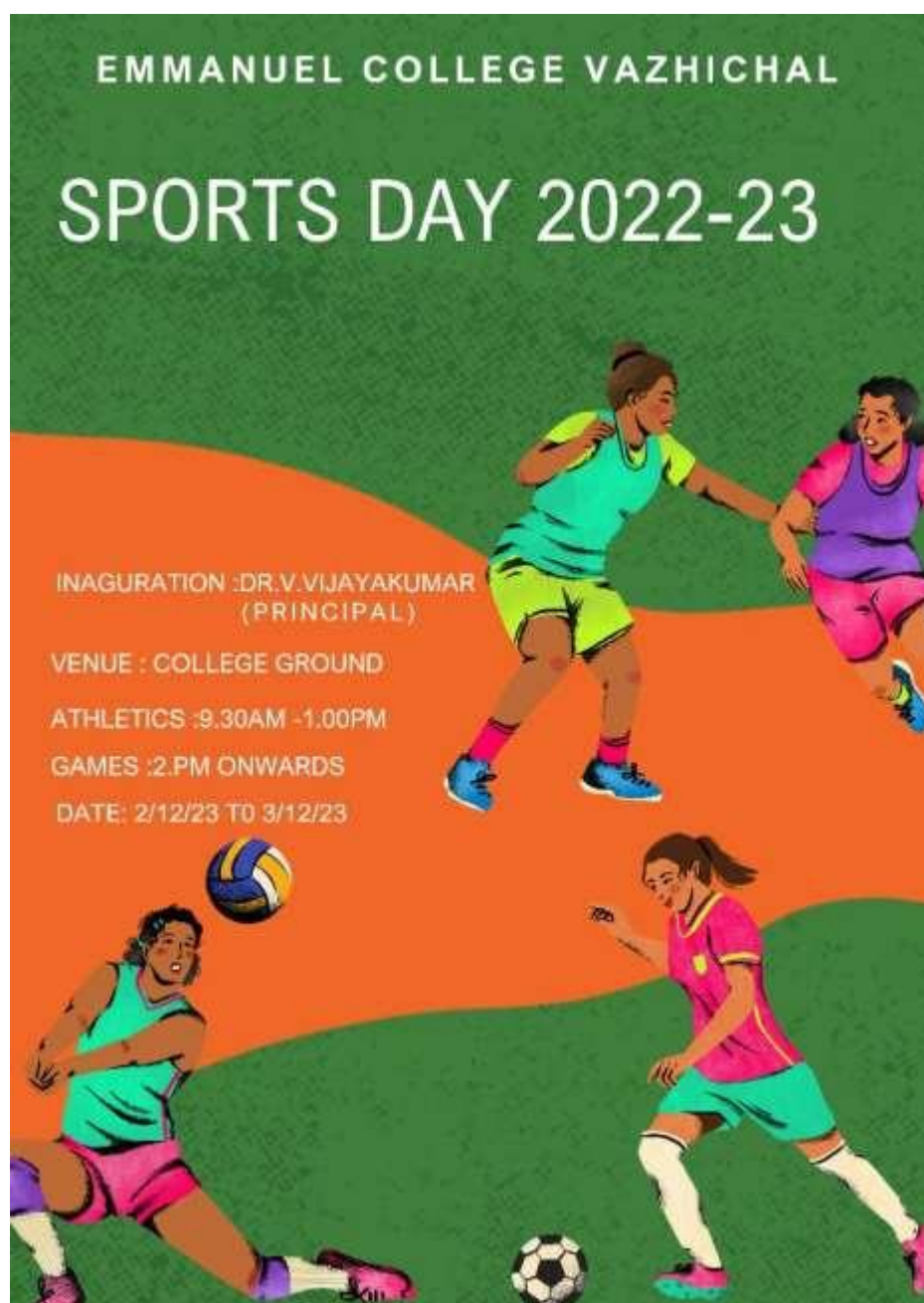
